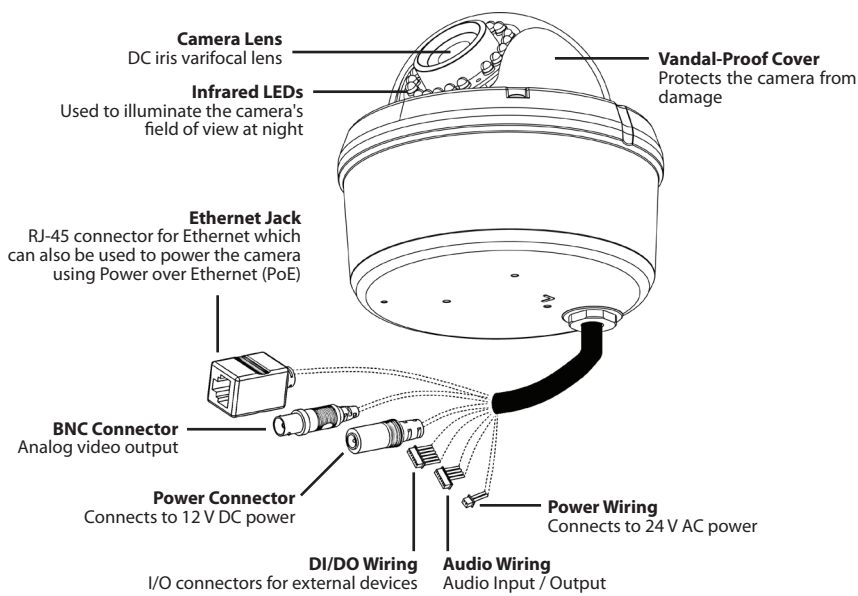

Product Overview



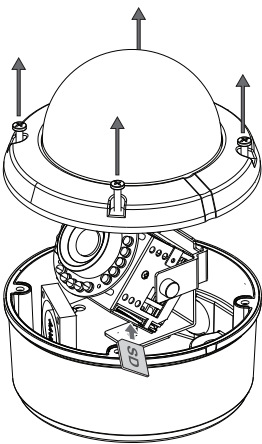
SD Card Installation

Disassemble the Camera

Open the camera enclosure by removing the 4 screws. Lift the dome off the base of the camera.

Install the SD Card

Push the SD card into the camera with the gold contacts oriented towards the base of the camera. To eject the SD card, push the SD card into the slot. Reassemble the camera.



Mounting

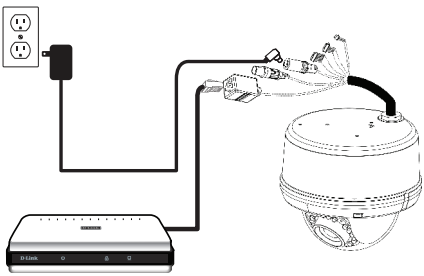
Please refer to the User Manual for several ways to mount your camera to a wall or ceiling.

Connect Your Camera

Step 1 - Connect the camera to a router or switch using an Ethernet cable. If you are using a Power over Ethernet (PoE) router or switch, make sure your cable is high quality and pinned properly to ensure a proper power connection.

Step 2 - Connect the supplied power supply to the 12V DC Power receptor on the camera and connect the other end to a power outlet. If you are using PoE, do NOT connect the power supply to the camera.

Note: There is a 24V AC connector on the camera which will allow you to connect to a power source such as your building's emergency power.



Step 3 - Insert the DCS-6510 CD into your computer's CD-ROM drive to begin the installation. If the Autorun function on your computer is disabled, or if the D-Link Launcher fails to start automatically, click **Start > Run**. Type **D:\autorun.exe**, where D: represents the drive letter of your CD-ROM drive.

Click **Setup Wizard** to begin the installation of your camera. Please refer to the user manual for more information on installation and configuration of your camera.
