* If Skype[™] is not already installed on your computer, please insert the CD and click "Install Skype" or visit http://www.skype.com to download latest version and follow the instructions there to install Skype[™]. Verify that Skype[™] is working before installing the DPH-50U adapter.

Installation

Do not connect the DPH-50U to your computer until instructed to do so by the DPH-50U installation wizard.

Insert the supplied CD into your PC CD-ROM drive. The installation should start automatically. If you do not have Skype[™] installed, click **Install Skype** before installing the phone adapter driver.

Telephone Installation

Connect a standard telephone handset to the DPH-50U phone jack using a RJ-11 telephone cable as shown below



Connect a telephone cable between the DPH-50U line jack and a wall jack as shown below. Note that this is only required for making regular phone calls, or for forwarding Skype[™] calls to your mobile (or other off-site) phone or for toll bypass applications.



You final configuration should resemble the following.



Making and Receiving Calls

You can continue to use the telephone handset connected to the DPH-50U D-Link USB VoIP Adapter to make and receive standard telephone calls as you used without any change. To make a standard phone call, just pick up the handset and dial as you normally would. Make sure you hear a dial tone before you dial ## or the phone number. To answer (receive) a standard phone call just pick up the handset when the phone rings.

When you receive an incoming Skype[™] call, the handset connected to the DPH-50U will ring. To answer the call, just pick up the handset and speak as you normally would. To end the call, simply hang up the handset as you normally would.

If you have SkypeOut[™], you can use the DPH-50U connected handset to make SkypeOut[™] calls by picking up the handset, pressing ## (only if the DPH-50U is in PSTN mode), to indicate to the DPH-50U that this will be a Skype[™] call, dialing as per the SkypeOut[™] recommended dialing sequence, 00 + country code + telephone number and pressing the asterisk (*) key. If the DPH-50U is already in VoIP mode, pressing ## is not required.

Examples:

PSTN mode: **## 001 617 555 1212** * VoIP mode: **001 617 555 1212** *

In order to make a call to a Skype[™] contact, you will need to use the Skype[™] program to assign a speed dial (as described in the user manual) to each person you would like to call from the DPH-50U connected handset. Then simply pick up the handset, press ## (if in PSTN mode), to indicate to the DPH-50U that this is a Skype[™] call, you will hear a new dial-tone, press the speed dial number (e.g. 22) and then press the asterisk (*) key.
